HOW TO APPLY & INTERVIEW DATES

Please read the below information before submitting your application form

General Application Information | Foundation Certificate

- We operate a rolling admissions process for the Foundation Certificate, we therefore encourage you to apply as early as possible
- The application processing fee is £60; this is for all applications and is non-refundable. This will be requested with an interview invitation
- References: two references need to be submitted before your interview date. A place being offered will depend on both references being received. References cannot be from a family member or your therapist
- Following interview and offer of place, you will be required to pay a deposit for the course within two weeks
- Acceptance of a place on this course is a contractual commitment to pay the full fee and refunds are not permitted if for any reason you do not complete the stage
- Throughout training you are required to be in personal counselling or psychotherapy (in person), with a therapist from our approved list (a minimum of 35 hours per year). Charges can vary, but we recommend budgeting around £60 per week.
- Due to bank charges on international payments there is an additional £10 charge
- Please note that our training requires attendance **in person**

You will also need to budget for:

- *A minimum of 35 hours in-person counselling or psychotherapy each year throughout the training from practitioners on the BCPC Approved Lists. Charges can vary, but we recommend budgeting around £60 per week.*
- *Supervision of your Private Practice will be required fortnightly from term 2 of year 2 (C2) onwards; the cost of this is £55 for each supervision session.*

You will also need to budget for: (see next page)

- *The cost of weekly in-person psychotherapy throughout the training with a psychotherapist from the BCPC Approved List. Charges can vary, but we recommend budgeting around £60 per week.*
- *The cost of fortnightly supervision from Module 1 onwards at a minimum cost of £55 per session.*
- *During submission stage: the cost of tutorials at £55 and reading fees that can be budgeted for at £50 per 4000 words: this will be confirmed by your submission tutor.*
